

Roll Neck Sweater Pattern

Child's Roll-neck Jumper Pattern

Sizes:	9-12 months, 18 months – 2 years, 3 years		
To fit Chest:	20/21ins	22/23 ins	24/25 ins
Length	11 ½ ins	13 ½ ins	14 ½ ins
Sleeve	8 ins	9 ½ ins	11 ½ ins
Materials:	Bowmont Arran 150g	200g	250g
Yarn	Small quantity if required for contrast roll-neck / motif		
	1 pair 3.75 mm (UK 9) Knitting needles		
	1 pair 4.5mm (UK 7) Knitting needles		

Tension: 21sts, 27rows to 4 ins square on size 4.5mm needles in st st

Abbreviations: st: stitch, k; knit, p: pearl, inc: increase, dec: decrease
St st; stocking stitch (k 1 row, p 1 row)

Style 1 with roll edges at sleeve and bottom edges

Back

Using 3.75 needles cast on 55 (**63**, 69) sts. Starting with p row work 5 rows st st, and 6 rows k1 p1 rib. Change to 4.5mm needles and st st to 11 ½ (**13** ½, 14 ½) ins or length required, ending p row.

Cast off 15(**18**,20)sts, for right shoulder, k 25(**27**,29) sts, for neck and put these sts on stitch holder, cast off 15(**18**, 20) sts for left shoulder.

Front

Work as for back until 16 rows less than back have been completed.

Knit 20(**23**, 26) sts, turn and work on these sts for right side of neck. P 1 row then work 5 rows dec 1 st at neck edge on every row. Work 9 rows without shaping and then cast off.

With right side facing slip 15(**17**, 17) sts on holder for neck, rejoin yarn and knit remaining sts, knit to end and complete as for first side of neck.

Sleeves

Using 3.75 needles cast on 31(**33**, 33) sts and work 5 rows st st (in contrast yarn if required). Then work 5 rows of rib and on 6th row of rib inc 10 sts evenly across row. Change to 4.5mm needles and continue in st st, increasing 1 st at each end of 3rd and following 6th rows to 55(**57**, 63) sts. Continue to 8(**9** ½, 11 ½)ins or length required. Cast off fairly loosely.

Roll-neck

Join right shoulder. With right side facing and 3.75 needles pick up and knit 15 sts along left neck edge, 15(**17**, 17) from stitch holder, 15 along right neck edge, and 25(**27**, 29) from stitch holder at back of neck. Work 6 rows in rib,

then in contrast yarn if required, work 6 rows st st starting with p row. Cast off loosely.

Making Up

Join remaining shoulder seam and neckband, sew in sleeves, join side seams and sleeve seams. Embroider or Swiss darn motif if required.

Style 2 with garter stitch borders on sleeve and bottom edges

Back and front

Using size 3.75 needles, cast on 53(**61**,67) sts. Work 9 rows garter stitch (in contrast yarn if required) then 6 rows in rib. Change to 4.5 needles and complete as for style 1, but inc 1 st at each end of first row.

Sleeves

Using 3.75 needles cast on 31(**33**, 33) sts. Work 7 rows garter st and 6 rows rib as for back and front but increasing 10 sts evenly on last row of rib. Continue as for style 1.

Complete jumper as for style 1.
